

**Randwick Parish Plan
Parish Meeting
Randwick Village Hall
18th November 2007**

Calvin Williams welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked them for making the time to attend the meeting. He then handed over to Richard Huxford for an overview of the plan and its progress to date.

Richard explained how the plan had come together following an extensive consultation exercise of Randwick parishioners. The exercise identified the details of the 5 key areas for development.

- Social and Leisure (activities, interests, facilities etc)
- Services (transport & other community services)
- Built environment (housing, roads etc)
- Natural environment (rural, landscape etc)
- General.Issues

The Parish Council have begun to take a number of actions against concerns expressed in the plan and the plan will now form the basis of grant applications to the councils well as informing all future actions of the parish.

Calvin then handed out an Action Plan Priorities Paper (see attached) and the group split in two to focus on the 2 groupings of actions and issues identified.

Following feedback from the 2 groups (see attached) the following interest groups were identified:

- Communications – Sheila Bliss, Dawn Hicks, Sue Tomlinson, Irene Byron, (village agent to be included)
- Youth Activity (to include funding & youth wide representation) – Ruth Rickman-Williams, Dawn Hicks
- Environment Survey – David Preece
- Design statement – Richard Huxford, Martin Rendell
- Traffic Survey – Martin Rendell

- Footpath/stile survey – Des Rawlings
- Welcome pack (to include environment) – Dawn Hicks, Brian Stanley, Padre Brian Wollaston, Ruth Rickman-Williams, Des Rawlings
- Website – Mick Cant, Dawn Hicks, Calvin Williams.

Working group meetings will be convened and progress will be reported back through the Parish Council. Parish Councillors with sub-group responsibilities will support the working groups. Other interested parties will be invited to join working groups according to interests.

Calvin then thanked everyone for their attendance and hard work and the meeting closed at 7.30pm

There are other commitments already in place which will tie in with the meeting outcomes, e.g. Tony Wilton has volunteered to help with the design statement, John Taylor is heading up the Twenty is Plenty initiative which will be linked with Whiteshill & Ruscombe, Tyrone Mein and Lucy Davidson have also volunteered to help with this.
